






- MIRROR ASSEMBLEY
- 2.1 THE SCREW HOLE OF THE BRACKET IS BIASED TO THE LEFT
- 2.2 THE SCREW HOLE OF THE BRACKET IS BIASED TO THE RIGHT
 - 3 HORIZONTAL BAR
 - 4 **BOLD**
 - 5 **GASKET**
 - 6 **SCREW NUT**
 - 7 WHEEL
 - 8 **LONG SCREW**
 - PORTABLE WRENCH

INSTALLATION STEP 1 Dance Fig.






- Place mirror 1 with its back facing up and place it on a flat surface
- Screw bolt 4 to the screw hole on the back of mirror 1
- Be careful not to tighten too much

INSTALLATION STEP 2






- Bracket B points left 2.1 right 2.2
- Put the triangular position of bracket 2 upward
- Align the screw hole of bracket 2 with the position of bolt 4, then install bracket 2 into bolt 4
- Finally align bracket 2 with the bottom surface of mirror 1

INSTALLATION STEP 3 Dance 31





- After installing the bracket, tighten the bolts
- Finally, install screw piece 4 into bolt 4
- Install the nut 6, and finally nut F with wrench 9

INSTALLATION STEP 4





- When connecting wheel 7 to the bottom frame
- Screw the hole of bracket 2, first tighten the circular position at the bottom of the wheel 7
- Then use wrench 9 to tighten the wheel nut

INSTALLATION STEP 5 Dance The





- Place the horizontal bar 3 on the back of mirror 1
- Align the screw holes and screw in the long screw 8 for the wrench 9 to tighten

MAINTENANCE



All components and fasteners should be inspected to ensure that your mirror is structurally sound, intact, and functional. Any damaged or broken parts should be replaced, and loose fasteners should be tightened. All maintenance work should be carried out by qualified technicians.

CLEANING: ALWAYS FOLLOW THE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS: Wipe with a clean, colorfast cloth dampened with mild alkaline-free soap and lukewarm water. Do not wet excessively. Remove all traces of any cleaning product by wiping with fresh water and a clean cloth. Dry with a soft, clean cloth.

Do not use:

- Hot or boiling water.
- Hydrocarbons, including alcohol.
- Acetone.
- Furniture polishes.
- Bleach.
- Concentrated detergents.
- Abrasive powder or paste cleaners.
- Steel wool.
- Silicon or petroleum-based agents.
- Solvent-based or abrasive cleaning agents.



METAL AREAS: Wipe using regular cleaning products that are recommended for stainless steel and metals

Do not use:

- Acetone.
- Furniture polishes.
- Bleach.
- Detergent.
- Abrasive cleaners.
- Steel wool.
